History

- Explain how some people have helped us to live better lives
- Explain how I have changed since I was born

- Explain what an object from the past might be used for

Geography

- Explain where I live and tell somebody my address

Art

- Show how people feel in paintings and drawings
- Describe what I can see and give an opinion about the work of an artist
- Ask questions about a piece of art

Music

- Use voice to speak, sing and chant

Design & Technology

- Use my own ideas to make something
- Choose appropriate resources and tools
- Cut food safely

RE

- What is Diwali and why is celebrated?
- Who is special in my life and why?
- What is the Christmas story?

Questions to Address (open and closed)

- Who is great in your life?
- How have you changed since you were born?
- What makes you great?
- What makes your favourite place so great?
- How do we know Florence Nightingale is a great person?
- What makes Diwali a great celebration?

Literacy Links

- Write simple sentences, words and phrases taken from the 'greatest' traditional tales such as The Gingerbread Man, Cinderella and Three Billy Goats Gruff.
- Create an in class display of bonfire night pictures and write labels and captions to match
- Read, write and perform a free verse poem
- Write a simple recount of Florence Nightingale as a nurse in Victorian Britain

ICT Links and activities

- Create a series of instruction for floor robots
- Plan a journey for a programmable toy
- Use technology safely

Science skills, investigations and links

(Science not linked to current adventure-focusing on animals, including humans)

- Name a variety of animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals
- Classify and name animals by what they eat
- Sort animals into categories
- Name parts of the human body and link the correct body parts to a sense
- Investigation - monitoring rainfall using a rain gauge

- Where does Florence Nightingale fit on our timeline?
- Creating tally charts to show our favourite traditional tales
- Exploring the value of coins - different ways to make amounts
